AWARDS TO BE PRESENTED:

Dr Alan Laughlin Perpetual Award(s)

Dr Alan Laughlin PSM FACE, served as Deputy Director General (Schools) for the NSW Department of Education and Training (DET) from which he retired in 2005. He is currently working part-time in a consultancy mode with various organisations including Catholic Education and as an Adjunct Professor with Charles Sturt University. In 2005 Alan was awarded the Public Service Medal (PSM) in the Australia Day Honors List. Alan is a Fellow of ACE and a Life Member.

Nominees for these awards are selected from across all sectors of education. The award will be presented to outstanding educators:

- In recognition of outstanding contributions to quality Leadership, and/or
- In recognition of outstanding contributions to improving the quality of teaching at their educational institution

Dr Ralph Rawlinson Perpetual Award

Dr Ralph Rawlinson FACE was appointed as Principal, Alexander Mackie College in 1974. In 1980 he was appointed as the Foundation Chairman of the NSW Education Commission, and in 1987 he spent two years as Planning Vice Chancellor of Chifley University (now Western Sydney). Since retiring from public office in 1988, he has been an international consultant for AusAID and the World Bank. Ralph has a particular interest in addressing disadvantage in education and continues to work on international projects. Ralph is a Fellow of ACE and a Life Member.

This award is made to an educator:

- who has made a significant contribution to the education of students with disadvantage at local, national or international level.

Dr Ron Ikin Perpetual Award

Dr Ron Ikin FACE (1937 – 2011) was a world renowned educator and promoter of public education. His particular interest was in supporting the professional development of aspiring and incumbent principals, linking his work to influential national and international networks in educational leadership programs. Ron was a Fulbright scholar, and a life member and Executive Officer of the NSW Institute of Senior Educational Administrators (ISEA). In 2010 Ron was awarded the Excellence in Educational Leadership Award by the University Council for Educational Administration, a council of more than 100 major universities in the USA. Ron was a Life Member of ACE and a Fellow of the College.

This award is made to an educator

- in recognition of outstanding leadership in professional learning at sector or system level

Certificates of Recognition for World Teachers Day 2018

All ACE regional groups in NSW will be presenting certificates to teachers who have a recommendation from their principal or supervisor, as worthy of being recognized for their teaching skills and commitment to the teaching profession.

Outstanding Graduate Award
