Award	Eligibility	Criteria for Nominators
Sir Harold Wyndham Medal	ACE member who has made an outstanding contribution to the education of young people in NSW and who supports and contributes to ACE at local state or national level	Identify and describe the nominee's contributions and their impact as a leader to the education of young people over an extended period of time within their workplace and beyond, and identify their contributions to ACE and its activities
Dr Paul Brock Medal	ACE Member (teacher) who inspires students and colleagues, has an exceptional commitment to the teaching profession and is a "point of light" for teachers, students and the wider education community	Focus on addressing the three criteria and describe how the nominee meets the criteria at a very high standard
Excellence in Education Awards	Individual educators or teams of educators who have demonstrated excellence in educational practice. This will include, but is not restricted to, excellence in curriculum development, student wellbeing, professional development, technology, pedagogy, leadership, innovation, scholarship, indigenous education, learning support and disability education	Describe and demonstrate the nominee's achievements and excellence in educational practice in their area of speciality
Outstanding Service Awards	ACE Member(s) who has made an outstanding contribution to ACE NSW at regional and/or state level, either over an extended period of time, and/or has made an outstanding contribution to an ACE NSW state priority program	Identify and describe the outstanding contributions to ACE NSW that demonstrate the nominee's exemplary service to the College
Young Professionals Award	ACE member in their first seven years of teaching who has demonstrated excellence in teaching practice and shown a high level of personal commitment to the teaching profession through innovation, leadership and/or scholarship	Identify and describe the nominee's achievements and practices which demonstrate the professionalism of the nominee
Media & Communications Awards	One award will be presented to a regional or state journalist in the print or electronic media who has consistently provided in depth and balanced coverage of educational issues or who has written a particularly outstanding article on a significant educational issue. One other award will be presented to an educator who has demonstrated innovation in the use of contemporary media to connect students with the global education community	Describe and demonstrate the nominee's outstanding contribution and achievements in these areas
Social Justice & Community Service Award	An individual, group, school or organisation who has: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • demonstrated a notable record of work in changing the social and cultural contexts that disadvantage, impoverish or disempower students • engaged in building a more just society by seeking to change those inhibiting social situations, demonstrating respect for the human dignity of all peoples • increasing learning opportunities for students in relation to human rights, social justice, social action, community development and grassroots action 	Identify and describe the activities undertaken and the changes which have occurred as a result of the program
