

ACE Events | Advice Coronavirus COVID019

The Australian College of Educators is continuing to monitor the changing novel coronavirus situation. It is following the guidance of the Commonwealth and State Health Departments on appropriate steps.

Key points for members and guests attending any upcoming ACE events:

- Anyone who has travelled overseas in the last 14 days should not attend an ACE event until they have self-quarantined for 14 days.
- You **cannot** attend an ACE event if you are within this self-quarantine isolation period.
- If you are in this situation, please contact the Australian College of Educators National Office on events@austcolled.com.au to advise us of your inability to attend and follow government health advice (see useful links below).
- At present ACE has adjusted our event terms and conditions. In the event you feel unwell up to and including the day of the event a refund will be made
- All events will be held according to our advertised calendar.
- If there is a need for any changes to the ACE events calendar those affected will be advised directly and a refund will be given.
- Any changes will also be notified through the ACE web page.

ACE advises that as the situation is evolving it will continue to act on the advice of the Commonwealth and State Health Authorities.
